

ESTATE WINERY

Located on the historic Silverado Trail in Napa Valley's Oak Knoll District, Black Stallion Estate Winery pays homage to the rich history of the 32-acre estate which was once home to the Silverado Equestrian Center. The property was purchased in 2010 by the Indelicato family, a fourth-generation family-owned company founded in 1924. Sourcing from the most prestigious vineyards, the winery is committed to making only the most expressive wines.

## TASTING NOTES

Our Limited Release Majestic Shadow 2021 Napa Valley Red Wine Blend highlights the wealth of grape growing in Napa Valley. The Cabernet Sauvignon is the main component of this blend and adds bold dark fruit flavors as well as layers of intense complexity and structure. The Malbec and Merlot soften and round out the blend, with brighter fruit and lower tannin levels. The Cabernet Franc adds a firm backbone with nice acidity. On the nose, the aromas are cassis, sandalwood, and clove. The flavors deliver notes of ripe blackberry and dark cherry. The tannins are broad, medium-weight, and smooth. The finish is rich and elegant.

## VINTAGE

Despite an unusually dry winter and warm spring, the 2021 growing season produced exceptionally high-quality fruit, some of the best in recent years. Early precipitation led to an ideal environment for our grapes to flower, bloom, and set in early spring, but lack of rainfall for the rest of the season reduced yields. The even ripening in the summer months allowed the grapes to develop bright, fresh, clean fruit flavors. This moderate weather and long ripening time were instrumental for developing smooth, flavorful, and exquisitely balanced wines. All in all, this was a remarkable year to taste the unique characteristics and terroir from Napa Valley's diverse regions.

## VINEYARD

The grapes for 2021 vintage come from amazing Valley and Mountain fruit growers from across the world renowned Napa Valley, including Oak Knoll District, Rutherford, Atlas Peak, Calistoga, and Coombsville. The Valley appellation fruit offers a lush and smooth texture that allows red wines to be enjoyed younger. The Mountain fruit from appellations like Atlas Peak give the wine greater structure, color and concentration.

## WINEMAKING

Our fruit for this blend is handpicked during the cool early morning hours at optimal ripeness. Upon arrival at the winery, the fruit is hand sorted before it is destemmed into small fermentation tanks, keeping lots separate. After three days of cold soaking, the must is gently warmed, and yeast was added to initiate fermentation. Gentle 'pump-overs' and punchdowns occurred many times during the 14-21-day primary fermentation, allowing for maximum extraction of fruit flavor, color, and tannin from the skins. We then allowed the free run wine to gravity flow from the skins directly to barrel. The skins were gently pressed, the wine going to barrels to mature separately. Portions of wine were allowed to mature for 17 months in oak barrels (63% new French Oak) before being blended and prepared for bottling.


